

# **SACRAMENTS & MINISTRY INFO**

### **ACTIVE PARISHIONER**

The criteria for an Active Parishioner are:

-Weekly participation in worship through attendance at Sunday Mass and on Holy Days of Obligation.

-Volunteer at St. Anthony's on regular basis (**Time**)
-Active involvement in a parish ministry/organization (**Talent**)
-Weekly or monthly use of parish envelopes or online giving
(**Treasure**)

### PARISH REGISTRATION AND SACRAMENTS

Those seeking to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony **must be registered members** for <u>at least six months</u> prior to reception of these Sacraments. You must be a registered member of the parish to ask for Godparent or Sponsor's form of eligibility.

### **Infant Baptism Class for Parents**

Parents must be registered and active member of St. Anthony's. Class is offered on the third Thursday of every month. Pre-registration is required. Please call the office to pre-register. Baptisms are not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

# First Holy Communion

Preparation begins in the first grade and continues into second grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week in August.

#### Confirmation

Preparation begins in the eighth grade and continues into ninth grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week of August. Adults who have not been confirmed and would like to receive the Sacrament are asked to contact the parish office.

#### Marriage

You must be registered and active member at least six months prior to preparation of the Sacrament. Couples should call the parish office and speak to the priest/ Deacon for pre-nuptial inquiries. Then the couple will begin formal marriage preparations at least six months prior to the wedding date.

### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

This is a process through which non-baptized adults known as catechumens or baptized adults who wish to convert from other faith traditions enter in communion with the Catholic Church. Classes begins in September. If you wish to become a Catholic, please call the parish office.

# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL -YEAR OF THE PARISH

The National Eucharistic Revival is a three-year invitation to discernment, encounter, and grassroot response on the diocesan, parish, and individual levels to an intimate relationship with our Lord Jesus Christ through the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. This invitation started on the Feast of Corpus Christi, on June 19, 2022, and it will end with a National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana on July 17, 2024.

We are now in the year of the Parish Revival which started on June 11, 2023, and will end on July 17, 2024. Since, June 2022 we have been holding the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at our parish as one of the responses to strengthening of our relationship with Jesus through the Eucharistic devotion. This is done every Friday from 9:45 am to 10:45 am.

As we are moving towards the end of the National Eucharistic Revival in July 2024, I am inviting all members of our parish family to spend a prayerful hour before the Blessed Sacrament at our parish. So, starting on Friday, January 12, 2024, through July 12, 2024, there will be an extended time for the Adoration of Blessed Sacrament.

In addition to the one which starts at 9:45 am through 10:45 am, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will always resume every Friday from 12 noon through 8:00 pm. All parish members will be invited each week to sign up for whatever hour is convenient to every and each individual. For example, one can sign up for 12 noon through 1:00 pm, or from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm etc. Each group with a maximum of 10 people, will be led by at least two Eucharistic Ministers.

It is my hope and prayer that all of us will take this wonderful opportunity to spend an hour with our Lord Jesus Christ, as we move towards the conclusion of the National Eucharistic Revival.

The extension of time for Adoration on Fridays will start on January 12, 2024. The 9:45 am to 10:45 am Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will continue as usual, and then it will resume after 11am Mass at 12 Noon.

Each and every one of us is invited to participate in this spiritual time. Let us show our faith in the Real Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

# THE STATUS OF THE NET INCOME FISCAL YEAR 2022 - 2023

A couple of months ago a hefty Net Income was announced in the Financial Report of the **Fiscal Year**; **July 2022 through June 2023**. Since then, there has been an interest from some members of the parish family in knowing more about the status of these funds.

That Net Income included funds which was a transfer from a closed account into a new parish account, funds for parish organizations, and funds for projects which were actually paid early in this current Fiscal Year; 2023 – 2024. The following is a summary of the Financial Fiscal Year Report:
