## **SACRAMENTS & MINISTRY INFO**

#### **ACTIVE PARISHIONER**

The criteria for an Active Parishioner are:

 -Weekly participation in worship through attendance at Sunday Mass and on Holy Days of Obligation.

-Volunteer at St. Anthony's on regular basis (**Time**)
-Active involvement in a parish ministry/organization (**Talent**)
-Weekly or monthly use of parish envelopes or online giving (**Treasure**)

#### PARISH REGISTRATION AND SACRAMENTS

Those seeking to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony **must be registered members** for <u>at least six months</u> prior to reception of these Sacraments. You must be a registered member of the parish to ask for Godparent or Sponsor's form of eligibility.

#### **Infant Baptism Class for Parents**

Parents must be registered and active member of St. Anthony's. Class is offered on the third Thursday of every month. Pre-registration is required. Please call the office to pre-register. Baptisms are not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

#### **First Holy Communion**

Preparation begins in the first grade and continues into second grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week in August.

#### Confirmation

Preparation begins in the eighth grade and continues into ninth grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week of August. Adults who have not been confirmed and would like to receive the Sacrament are asked to contact the parish office.

#### Marriage

You must be registered and active member at least six months prior to preparation of the Sacrament. Couples should call the parish office and speak to the priest/ Deacon for pre-nuptial inquiries. Then the couple will begin formal marriage preparations at least six months prior to the wedding date.

#### Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

This is a process through which non-baptized adults known as catechumens or baptized adults who wish to convert from other faith traditions enter in communion with the Catholic Church. Classes begins in September. If you wish to become a Catholic, please call the parish office.

### SPIRITUAL LIFE

### FROM THE DESK OF OUR ADMINISTRATOR Fr. Emerson Rodriguez Delgado

Jesus often used parables to teach us about the kingdom of God. These stories help us perceive and experience life in a new light. Through parables, Jesus prompted people to anticipate God's presence in their everyday lives and acknowledge that God's kingdom operates on its own timing, growth, and power of transformation.

These parables challenge us to hope for something greater and to embrace the mystery of life and God's kingdom. As Einstein noted, "The most beautiful and profound experience is the feeling of mystery." Jesus invites us into the profound depths of spiritual understanding.

In today's world, our pursuits often revolve around success, significance, and power. However, Jesus teaches us to value patience, to find purpose in failure, and to see worth in what may appear insignificant and irrelevant. These seemingly ordinary aspects of our life can reveal to us that God's kingdom is already here.

Paula D'Arcy profoundly captures this when she says, "God comes to you disguised as your life." This notion can be difficult to accept, particularly during chaotic, tragic, messy, and incoherent times. But Christianity encompasses more than just reaching heaven; it involves recognizing and nurturing God's presence here and now.

Similarly, in his book "The Power of Now," Eckhart Tolle writes, "Whatever the present moment contains, accept it as if you had chosen it. Always work with it, not against it. Make it your friend and ally, not your enemy. This will miraculously transform your whole life."

The kingdom of God exerts a quiet yet powerful influence in the hearts of those who embrace His rule in their lives. Jesus proclaimed, "The kingdom of God is among you and within you." It works in hidden ways, much like seeds growing in the ground, exemplifying that God's kingdom embodies humility, love, patience, and service.

The Gospel often presents paradoxes: the first will be last, the weak will be strong, and the greatest will be the least. It challenges our usual way of thinking.

To be fruitful in life, we need to be open to God's grace. God is already here, disguised as our everyday lives. Therefore, we are invited to trust in His presence as St. Paul reminds us: "we walk by faith, not by sight. Yet we are courageous." This faith calls us to trust deeply in God's unseen hand at work.

We can find and experience God's kingdom here and now by paying attention to what happens, being amazed by God's work in us, and sharing our experiences with others.

In a nutshell, my friends, Jesus' parables help us understand and embrace the mystery of God's kingdom in our midst, to value the hidden and the humble and the small, and to recognize that God's presence is woven into the fabric of our daily existence. Let us open our hearts to this profound truth and allow Him to transform our lives.

Many blessings to our fathers and father figures who are here with us and those who have passed into God's eternity on this Father's Day!


