

SACRAMENTS & MINISTRY INFO

ACTIVE PARISHIONER

The criteria for an Active Parishioner are:

- Weekly participation in worship through attendance at Sunday Mass and on Holy Days of Obligation.
- Volunteer at St. Anthony's on regular basis (**Time**)
- Active involvement in a parish ministry/organization (**Talent**)
- Weekly or monthly use of parish envelopes or online giving (**Treasure**)

PARISH REGISTRATION AND SACRAMENTS

Those seeking to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, Confirmation, and Matrimony **must be registered members** for **at least six months** prior to reception of these Sacraments. You must be a registered member of the parish to ask for Godparent or Sponsor's form of eligibility.

Infant Baptism Class for Parents

Parents must be registered and active member of St. Anthony's. Class is offered on the third Thursday of every month. Pre-registration is required. Please call the office to pre-register. Baptisms are not celebrated during the Season of Lent.

First Holy Communion

Preparation begins in the first grade and continues into second grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week in August.

Confirmation

Preparation begins in the eighth grade and continues into ninth grade for a total of two years of preparation. Registration for Religious Education classes takes place in August. The first day of class is the third or fourth week of August. Adults who have not been confirmed and would like to receive the Sacrament are asked to contact the parish office.

Marriage

You must be registered and active member at least six months prior to preparation of the Sacrament. Couples should call the parish office and speak to the priest/ Deacon for pre-nuptial inquiries. Then the couple will begin formal marriage preparations at least six months prior to the wedding date.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

This is a process through which non-baptized adults known as catechumens or baptized adults who wish to convert from other faith traditions enter in communion with the Catholic Church. Classes begins in September. If you wish to become a Catholic, please call the parish office.

SPIRITUAL LIFE

FROM THE DESK OF OUR ADMINISTRATOR Fr. Emerson Rodriguez Delgado

This Sunday, we're reminded of Jesus' mission entrusted to his disciples: to spread His message, heal the afflicted, and liberate the oppressed. This mission, rooted in their encounter with Jesus, serves as a reminder from St. Paul that each of us has been chosen for this very purpose. Like Amos, we are encouraged to step beyond our comfort zones and deliver God's message to those on the fringes of society.

This mission is not just about preaching; it's about touching lives in a holistic manner, addressing the deepest needs of the human spirit, and guiding people towards a life of purpose and meaning. Our mission is to invite others to encounter Christ in their own unique way. To achieve this, we must embody certain values: selflessness, patience, humility, simplicity, and perseverance. These qualities are essential for building meaningful relationships with others and creating an authentic witness to Christ.

As the Brazilian bishop Dom Helder Camara so wisely reminded us, "Your lives may be the only Gospel your listeners will ever read." In a world grappling with crises of the soul, our lives and actions become the beacon of hope and faith and a source of spiritual nourishment. Our genuine commitment and authentic witness can bring solace to those who hunger for transcendence and a deeper connection with God.

As we reflect on our own lives and the life of our church, we must question ourselves: Is our church functioning as a "field hospital," ready to embrace and care for those in need and wounded? Are we living up to the commission of Jesus? Have we strayed from our path? Are we failing to support people in their struggles? The call for conversion is more urgent than ever.

Our world yearns for a Church that listens and welcomes, especially to those who feel disconnected from faith. We must open our hearts to their doubts, questions, and struggles. By doing so, we can create a safe haven where people can find solace, understanding, and a sense of belonging.

The Church, recognizing these needs, has initiated the ongoing Synod. This process of listening and consulting is a step towards evangelization. Through genuine dialogue and compassionate accompaniment, we can demonstrate how the Church actively lives out its mission of embracing and supporting those who are marginalized.

In wrapping up, while it is God's grace that ultimately brings people back to faith, we all bear the responsibility to do everything within our power to guide people back to Him. As we conclude today's liturgy and are strengthened by the Eucharist, we are sent forth to share the Gospel. Let us go forth with courage and determination and letting nothing hold us back. May God set our hearts ablaze with His love and compassion for others. Peace and every good to Y'all.


